

## The Vienna Pass at a glance

### What is the Vienna Pass?

An all-inclusive sightseeing card for tourists visiting Vienna.

Vienna Pass holders get free admission to over 60 sights and unlimited rides on the hop on hop off buses of Vienna Sightseeing Tours.

### Sights

The attractions included in the Vienna Pass are some of the absolute tourist highlights of Vienna, such as Schönbrunn Palace, the Giant Ferris Wheel, the Danube Tower, Albertina, the Hofburg Imperial Palace, the Schönbrunn Zoo, the Kunsthistorisches Museum Vienna (museum of art history) or the Spanish Riding School, as well as numerous other museums, exhibitions, galleries, sights and tourist attractions, which can all be visited free of charge. ### Hop on hop off buses

The Vienna Pass grants unlimited use of hop on hop off buses on all routes during its validity. There are six routes with a total of 50 stops. The buses provide free audio guides in 16 languages, a children's channel in German and English, and free Wi-Fi.

### Fast lanes

Fast lanes at many attractions allow visitors to enjoy the sights without queues.

### Tickets and prices (Valid from 1st April 2019)

All Vienna Pass variants are available for consecutive calendar days.

Adults:

1-day pass: 70 Euro

2-day pass: 95 Euro

3-day pass: 125 Euro

6-day pass: 155 Euro

These tickets save visitors money from the fourth sight onwards.

### Concessions:

Children below age 6 get free admission to the all-inclusive offers if accompanied by a Vienna Pass holder. Under 19-year-olds pay half price.

- . The tourist information offices at Vienna Main Station, at Albertinaplatz in the city centre, or at the airport
- . At the ticket office of the Vienna Giant Ferris Wheel
- . Many hotels
